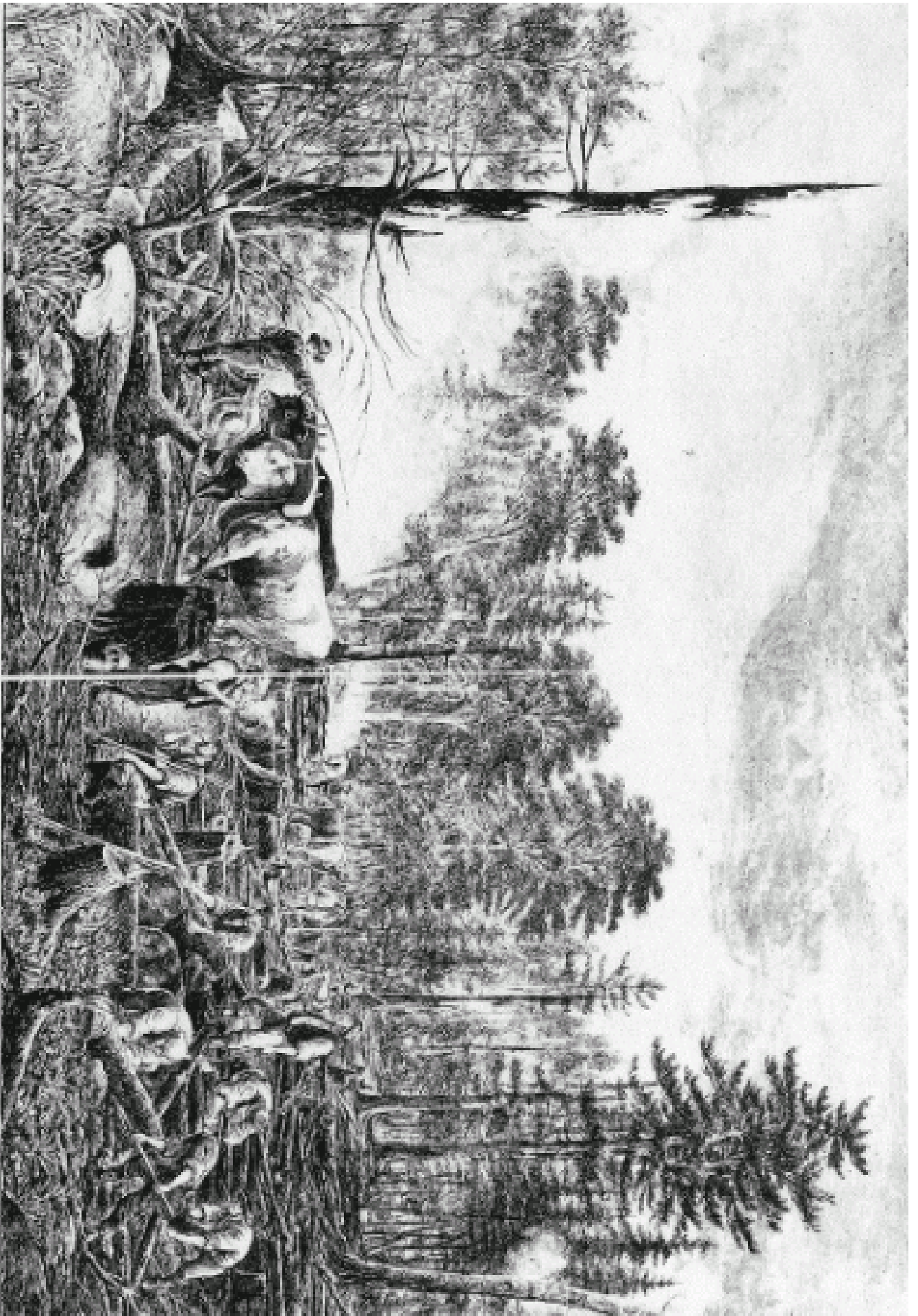

When my little house was first built, it was in the winter, and the snow was deep. The house of the first winter is taken from the house.

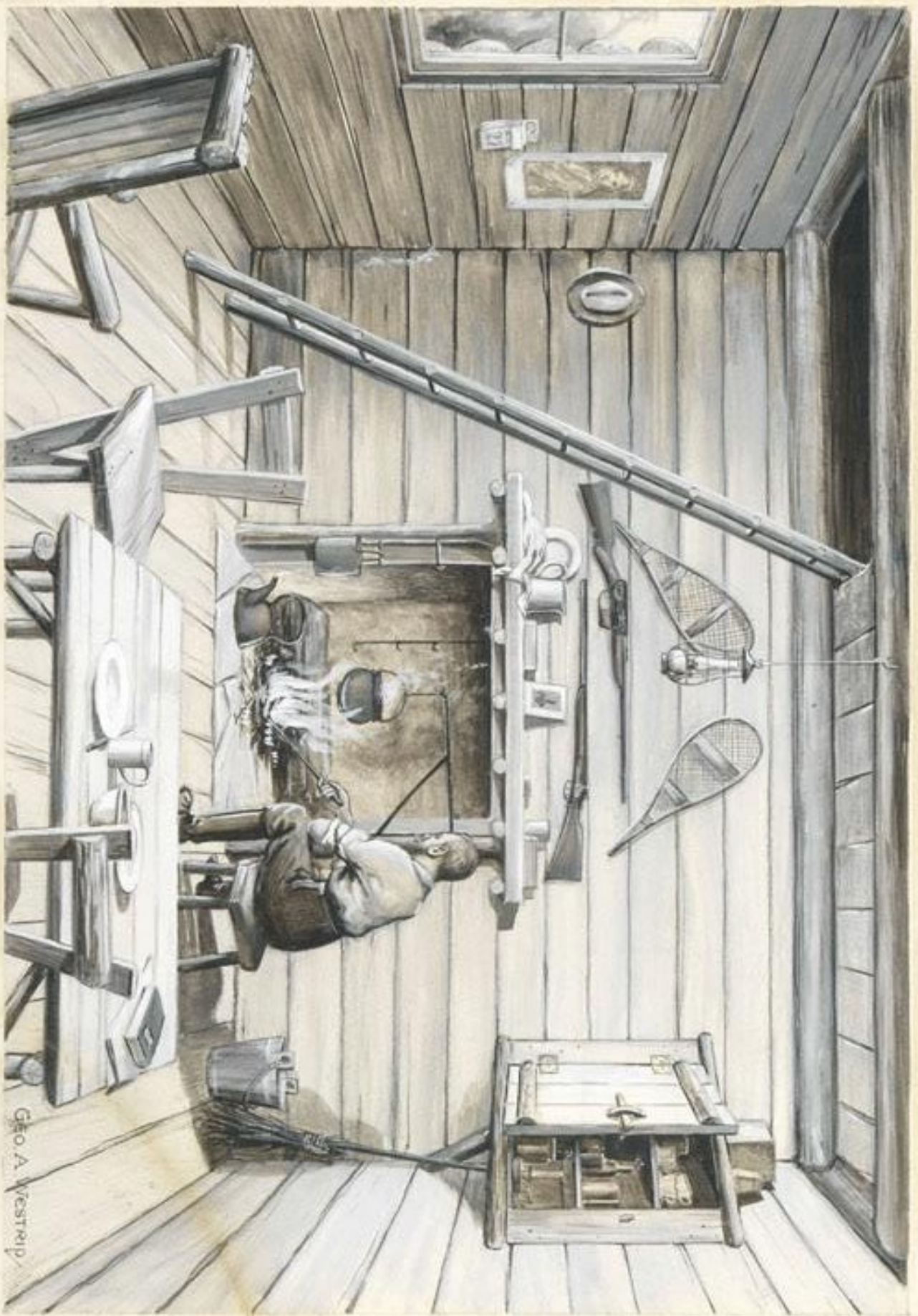

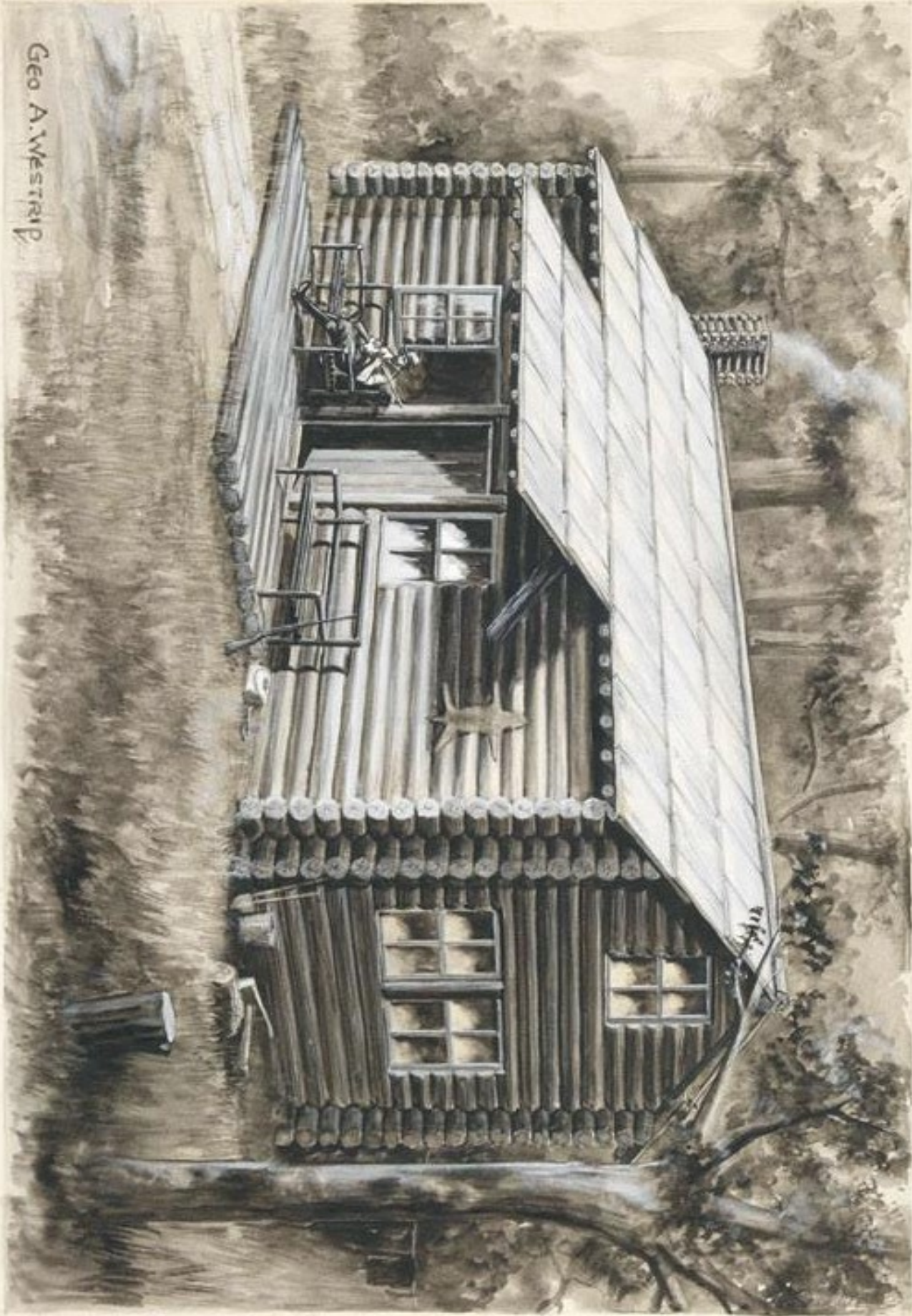
